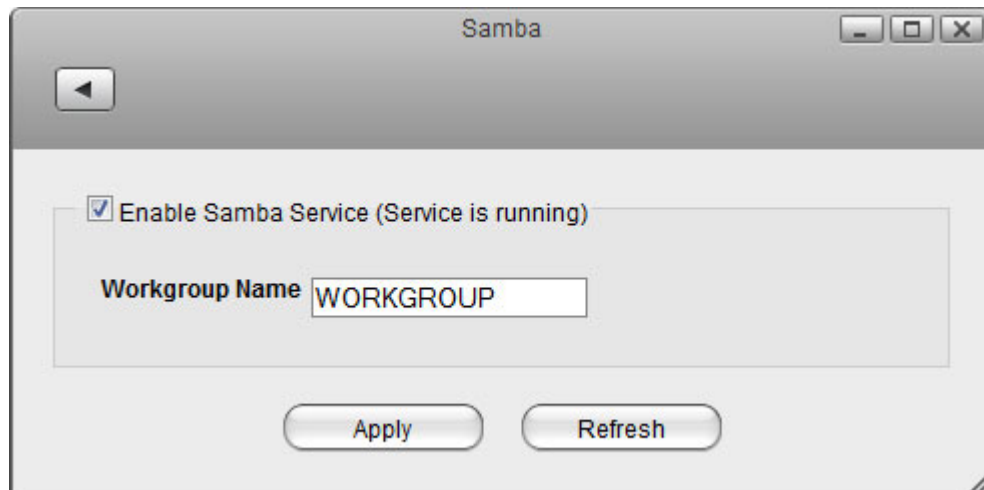


# Samba

Samba provides file services for Microsoft Windows clients and can be integrated with a Windows Server domain. Enable this service so that you can manage files via Network Neighborhood on a Windows PC.



Field	Description
<b>Enable Samba Service</b>	Select the check-box to enable the Samba service. The current state of the service is displayed as "Service is stopped" or "Service is running".
<b>Workgroup Name</b>	Specifies the Workgroup that the network drive belongs to. In most cases, the name is <b>WORKGROUP</b> .
<b>Apply</b>	Click <b>Apply</b> to save the changes.
